EGB De Cymru - Trophy information (Revised 2022)

Distance Awards and Group Trophies are presented at the Group's Branch Annual Meeting and Dinner. Any Member unable to attend but in receipt of an Award should contact the Trophy Secretary to arrange collection or posting.

Important - please note.

Rule 1

Any award which includes "Distance" can include Pleasure or Fun Rides (not necessarily EGB ones) BUT a Claim MUST be made on the Claim Form (available from the Group website and to be completed and returned to the Trophy Secretary by November 21st). This deadline is set so that we can order rosettes ready for the Branch Annual Meeting.

Rule 2

Trophies which are awarded on National Points will be calculated on information available to the Trophy Secretary from EGB. National Distance may also be calculated and used for Distance Awards but a Claim must be made for non-EGB Rides if required.

Please get your claim forms emailed by November 21st as after that date you may not get your rosette.

Annual Distance Awards

Rosettes can be claimed in increments of 100km (Horse and Rider) up to 500km - 1 per year. At least one Ride must be an EGB RIDE (Competitive or Pleasure). Riders should submit Claims for other Rides simply stating the Ride name and Distance ridden. Claims start from 100k.

Only up to 300Km can be claimed by non-members and supporters.

Junior Rosettes

To be awarded to Riders 16 years of age and under (see Rules above as need to be claimed)

First 80/120/160 km (in one day)

To be awarded to Horse or Rider and MUST be claimed.

Grade 1 Rosettes

To be awarded in accumulative increments of 400km and subject to claim being submitted.

Annual Trophies – Rosettes awarded to 3rd place.

Pantyfid Rocky - for High DISTANCE registered Native. Kms from any competitive or non - competitive to count (see Rules above)

Efosa Trophy - for HIGH DISTANCE Thoroughbred or Part bred TB Rules as previous Trophy

Beluga Trophy- for High DISTANCE Unregistered Horse or Pony (Rules AS previous)

High POINT Arabian
Based on National Points
High POINT Part - Bred Arabian
Based on National Points

Ride Wales Trophy- for High DISTANCE Other breeds or Part Bred Horse or Pony not specified in above trophies.

Nerina Trophy- for High POINT Novice Horse or Rider or Combination not to have completed 3 Rides in a previous season. 50 additional points awarded for Novice Rider and Horse combination. Please indicate on Claim Form.

Gemma Trophy- for High Point Open Horse or Pony

Golynos Trophy – High Point horse or pony in GERs only.

Robbie Trophy-- High POINT veteran Horse or Pony 18 or over

Thomas Cup- for High POINT Junior or Young Rider

Lady Marina Cup - for High POINT Mare

Troed y Rhiw Trophy - for High POINT Stallion or Gelding

Goldenaire Cup - for High POINT Rider (riding one or more horse or pony)

Jones Trophy - to be awarded by the Committee to a non-riding helper or volunteer

DE Cymru Trophy - to be awarded to Volunteers

A Claim must be submitted for this.

The De Cymru Championship is an Award aimed at acknowledging our volunteers and helpers. It needs to be submitted as a Claim as we wouldn't necessarily have the records needed.

Points are awarded as follows:
Attending a Group non- riding event 1
Attending a Group Local Ride 1
Volunteering at a Group non- riding event 2*
Volunteering at a Group Local or National Ride 2*
Organising a Group non - riding event 3
Organising a Local Group Ride 3
Organising a National Ride 3
* includes providing administrative support.
